IS 'CRAM' ALWAYS THE ANSWER TO THE CLUE 'STUDY HARD' IN CROSSWORDS?

NOT ALWAYS, BUT 'CRAM' IS ONE OF THE MOST COMMON AND CONCISE ANSWERS FOR THE CLUE 'STUDY HARD'.

HOW CAN I CONFIRM THE CORRECT ANSWER FOR THE CLUE 'STUDY HARD' IN A CROSSWORD?

CHECK THE NUMBER OF LETTERS REQUIRED AND INTERSECTING WORDS IN THE PUZZLE TO DETERMINE IF THE ANSWER IS 'CRAM' OR ANOTHER SYNONYM LIKE 'PREP'.
