They begin by adding simple inflectional endings, then common prefixes and suffixes to root words. They might turn play, for example, into a dozen or more words, including plays, playing, playful, displaying, and playfully. Soon they are building powerful words such as con-struction and de-part-ment. Once students learn to construct big words, they will be better able to deconstruct big words they see in their reading into manageable word parts.
