The models he proposes are based on preference rules, which are criteria for evaluating a possible structural analysis of a piece of music. He proposes a framework for the description of musical styles based on preference rule systems and explores the relevance of preference rule systems to higher-level aspects of music, such as musical schemata, narrative and drama, and musical tension.
